



ORDER

In pursuance of Hon'ble Prime Minister's call to curb Single Use Plastics (SUPs) by 2022 and as part of the "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" event, the following activities may be acted upon for reducing SUPs in the Office of the Arunachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board with immediate effect:

1.	All the Staffs may curb the use of Single-use Plastic items/disposable plastic items including:
	a) All types of plastic carry bags; and
	b) Plastic/thermocool (polystyrene) disposable cutlery including plates/cups/glass, bowls, knives, forks, spoons, containers, straws etc. used for serving eatables/drinks.
2.	Further, all the Staffs of the Board may discourage the use of plastic products including:
	a) Artificial flowers, flex banners, flags, flower pots;
	b) PET plastic water bottles;
	c) PVC/Plastic folders, trays etc. and
	d) Any other plastic material for which an alternative exists.
3.	All the Staffs of the Board may promote and practice source segregation.

Henceforth, this office is declared as '**Single use Plastic free zone**'.
