NOTIFICATION

The 29th June, 2022

No. FOR.(Env)/238/2021/1022-1082.—Whereas, a clean and safe environment is of paramount importance for the present day world and the citizens of the country have a fundamental right to a wholesome, clean and decent environment as per the Constitution of India for the well-being and survival of all living creatures on Earth.

And whereas, Article 48-A of the Constitution of India mandates the State to endeavour to protect and improve the environment and to safeguard the forests and wildlife of the country.

And whereas, the ongoing indiscriminate use of non-biodegradable plastic is a serious environmental hazard and it causes irreparable damage to the environment.

And whereas, the protection, improvement of the environment as well as prevention of hazards to human beings, other living creatures, plants and property from the harmful effects of non-biodegradable plastic is the role of the State Government and also the responsibility of its people, individuals, agencies, etc.

And whereas, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh has adopted the Pakke Tiger Reserve 2047 Declaration on Climate Resilient and Responsive Arunachal Pradesh with strategic interventions under Sustainable and Adaptive living in the State

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India has notified the Plastic Waste Management Amendment (PWM) Rules, 2021, in the Gazette of India vide GSR No. 571 (E) on 12th August 2021, which provided for insertion of the following in the PWM Rules 2016 which reads as under :-

1. In the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 2, in sub-rule (l), after the word "Importers", the words, "brand-owner, plastic waste processor (recycler, co-processor, etc.)" shall be inserted.

2. In the said rules, in rule 3,

(i) after clause (n), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :-

'(na) "Non-woven plastic bag" means Non-woven plastic bag made up of plastic sheet or web structured fabric of entangled plastic fibers or filaments (and by perforating films) bonded together by mechanical or thermal or chemical means, and the "non-woven fabric" means a flat or tufted porous sheet that is made directly from plastic fibres, molten plastic or plastic films ;

(ii) after clause (q), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :-

(qa) "Plastic waste processing" means any process by which plastic waste is handled for the purpose of reuse, recycling, co-processing or transformation into new products :

(iii) after clause (v), the following clauses shall be inserted, namely :-

'(va) "Single-use plastic commodity" mean a plastic item intended to be used once for the same purpose before being disposed of or recycled ;

'(vb) "Thermoset plastic" means a plastic which becomes irreversibly rigid when heated and hence cannot be remoulded into desired shape ;

'(vc) "Thermoplastic" means a plastic which softens on heating and can be moulded into desired shape ;

3. In the said rules, in rule 4, -

(a) in sub-rule (1),-

- (i) for the words "importer stocking", the words "import, stocking" shall be substituted ;
- (ii) in clause (c), for the words "fifty microns in thickness" , the words, figures, letters and brackets "seventy five microns in thickness with effect from the 30th September, 2021 and one hundred and twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from the 31 st December, 2022" shall be substituted;
- (iii) in clause (h), after the words, "carry bags", the words "and commodities" shall be inserted ;
- (iv) in clause (h), after the words, "compostable plastic carry bags", the words "or commodities or both" shall be inserted ;
- (v) after clause (i), following clause shall be inserted, namely :-

" (j) non-woven plastic carry bag shall not be less than 60 Gram Per Square Meter (GSM) with effect from the 30th September, 2021."

(b) after sub-rule (1), the following sub-rules shall be inserted, namely :-

"(2) The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic, including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July, 2022:-

- (a) ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration;
- (b) plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.
- (3) The provisions of sub-rule (2) (b) shall not apply to commodities made of compostable plastic.
- (4) Any notification prohibiting the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of carry bags, plastic sheets or like, or cover made of plastic sheets and multilayered packaging and single-use plastic, including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities, issued after this notification, shall come into force after the expiry of ten years, from the date of its publication".

The Government of Arunachal Pradesh endorses the MoEF&CC, Gol Notification GSR No. 571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 and therefore in pursuance of above, ***the usage of Single Use Plastics as mentioned under Sl. No. 4 (b) of this said notification are banned with effect from 1st July, 2022 and carry bags made of virgin or recycled plastic of not less than 120 microns in thickness shall be banned with effect from 31st December, 2022.***

WHEREAS, Rules 23 (1) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and Rule 16 of Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rule, 2018 specifies the duty of Department in-charge of local bodies of the concerned State Government or Union territory administration to constitute State Level Advisory Body within six months from the date of notification.

NOW, THEREFORE, in implementation of Rules 23 (1) of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and Rule 16 of Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rule, 2018, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is please to constitute the State Level Advisory Committee with following members.

NOTIFICATION

In compliance with PRAGATI meeting held on 24th February' 2021 on elimination of single use plastic and OM issued vide F.No.17/6/2021-HSM, dated 16th April' 2021 by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute a **Special Task Force** consisting of the following members, for taking measures to eliminate single use plastic and to prepare comprehensive action plan with timeline for implementation in mission mode.

The Terms of Reference for State Level Special Task Force for taking measures to eliminate Single Use Plastic in mission mode are as under:

1. Prepare a comprehensive Action Plan for implementation of PWMR 2016 and phasing out of SUPs, with identified activities and timelines and synergizing efforts and resources of various Departments/Agencies at State, District and City Level.
2. Assess plastic waste generation in State/UT with respect to collection, recycling and end of life disposal and identify gaps in plastic waste management (reduce, Reuse and Recycle)-policy, implementation, enforcement, infrastructure etc.
3. Strengthen policy, regulation, institutional mechanisms/structures for the implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules (PWMR), 2016 and phasing out of Single Use Plastic (SUP) in the State/UT, design appropriate management strategies and allow for allocation of financial resources for PWM including leveraging of funds from Swachh Bharat Mission.
4. Take measures for effective enforcement of (i) Plastic Waste Management Rule, 2016, as amended, and (ii) state/UT specific bans imposed on identified single use plastic items.
5. Develop policies for supporting the adaptation of alternatives to identified single use plastic items prohibited under PWMR, 2016, as amended.
6. Take measures to strengthen ULBs/GPs for segregation, collection, storage, transportation, processing, disposal of plastic waste.
7. Take measures for effective monitoring of implementation of PWM Rule, 2016, as amended.

8. Prepare a detailed road map for activities to build awareness and outreach among public on plastic waste management and reduction in the use of SUP items.
9. Develop strategy for building a strong public movement for mitigation of plastic pollution by involving education institutions (School, College, Universitas), NCC, NSS, Scout, Youth Clubs, Eco Clubs, Opinion makers and voluntary organizations with a details action plan in this regard.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
